A Ministerial Committee, which I am a member of and with DPM Teo Chee Hean in the chair, has been formed to consider the options in respect of 38 Oxley Road (and the implications thereof). The Committee will look into various aspects, including what Mr Lee's thinking on the matter was¹.

Public statements have been made about what Mr Lee Kuan Yew wanted done with the house at 38 Oxley Road after he passed away. In addition, Mr Lee Kuan Yew had written to Cabinet in 2010 and 2011 expressing his views on the matter.

The Committee would like to know if there are any points you would like to make to us, about what Mr Lee Kuan Yew's thinking was (in respect of 38 Oxley Road), and the context/circumstances relating to his thinking/wishes, beyond what has already been stated in public.

If there are matters you would like to tell us, please let us hear from you by 15 August 2016.
