Mr George Wei obtained his Diploma in Law (post-graduate) from the School of Oriental & African Studies, University of London in 1978, and later obtained his Masters in Law with a mark of distinction from the University College London in 1984. Mr Wei has been called to the Bar of England & Wales (1977), Hong Kong (SAR) and Singapore (1983). Mr Wei's teaching experience in Singapore goes back to 1979 when he was engaged as a part-time tutor for a term at the National University of Singapore (then University of Singapore)'s ("NUS") Faculty of Law. Thereafter, Mr Wei returned to Hong Kong where he was called to the Bar.
